What God Delights In (Luke 12:32; Romans 10:12-13; Psalms 91:14-16)

## Obstacles to God's Blessing (James 1:12-17; Hebrews 11:24-27)

- What are the three key areas that prevent us from receiving God's best?
- Why does Jesus want us to have dominion over the world?
- What are the some of the things a person weak in faith trades away foolishly which prevents them from receiving God's blessings?

Keys to God's Blessing (Philippians 3:12-14; Colossians 3:1-2; 1 John 4:18; Deuteronomy 3:16)

- What are the three key areas the enable us to receive God's best?
- How can we in practical sense set our minds on the things that are above?
- What role does fear have in the life of a Christian and how seriously do we hold on what God's reveals in His word about fear?
