**Real Faith Produces Godly Actions** (James 2:21-26; Hebrews 11:17-19, 31)

- How do Abraham (Hebrews 11:17-19) and Rahab (Hebrews 11:31) prove James’ point?
- What role does God have in our faith?
- What is the importance of evaluating our faith?
