- **Discussion Starter:** What additional insights have you gained about what it means to see Jesus as “KING of KINGS and LORD OF LORDS” and what impact should this have on our lives?

Jesus is the Divine King (Isaiah 6:1-4; John 12:36-43; Colossians 1:15; 1 John 5:20)

- Which sections of Isaiah 6:1-4 best describe Jesus as the Divine King and why?
- According to John 12:36-43, how is it that we know that Isaiah’s vision was of Jesus?

Jesus is the Supreme King (Isaiah 6:1-4)

- Which sections of Isaiah 6:1-4 best describe Jesus as the Supreme King and why?

Jesus is the Exalted King (Isaiah 6:1; Hebrews 1:8; Psalm 104:1; Revelation 19:16)

- What insights can we glean from Hebrews 1:8 that depict Jesus as the Exalted King?
- What is the significance of the robe Jesus was wearing and how is it described in Isaiah 6:1 as compared to Revelation 19:16?

Jesus is the Holy King (Isaiah 6:2-5; Revelation 5:10)

- Describe in your own words the magnitude of what is going on in heaven with the seraphim, the worship and the smoke. What impact did this have on Isaiah according to Isaiah 6:5? How should this impact us in our worship of Jesus?

Jesus is the Saving King (Isaiah 6:5-8; 2 Samuel 12:3)

- Explain the symbolism in Isaiah 6:6-7, of the seraphim flying with the hot coal and touching Isaiah’s lips.
- Compare Isaiah’s response in verse 8 to verse 5. What is the significance of each of his responses and how does this apply to us today?
