"Jesus Plus" is not the gospel (verse 18)

- Why is worshiping angels a problem? How do we know what is appropriate to worship?

- Read Romans 1:16. How does this apply to this discussion?

To be established is relationship over religion (verses 19-23)

- What does Paul mean by "not holding fast to the Head"?
- If you are not getting guidance from Jesus, where do you typically turn for guidance? For the definition right and wrong?
- What does it mean to compartmentalize our lives? What are the positive things about this?
- What are the dangers of compartmentalization? Which compartments are directed by Jesus? Who is directing the other compartments?
- Read Romans 6:3-4. How is this related to being cheated?
- If we are not required to follow religious rules for our salvation, then what is their purpose?
- What does it mean that Jesus is the fulfillment of scripture?
- How is "Jesus Plus" a form of bondage? See Mark 7:6-8. How does this cheat you of your reward?
