Discussion Starter

Faith in Jesus Christ is the only way for reconciliation with God (Salvation). Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-11 – How does the gospel message provide hope that other faiths lack? How does the reality of the gospel message effect out lives on a daily basis?

Jesus is God

- How did Jesus's life influence history and humanity?
- Who does scripture say that Jesus is? (Revelation 1:8) What kind of signs did Jesus provide to demonstrate his divinity? Name five of these signs.

Jesus is the only savior

- Read Revelation 1:5, John 14:6, and Acts 4:12. What do these verses say about how we are to be reconciled to God? What does it mean to be "saved" from our sins? Why is salvation necessary?
- Read 1 Timothy 2:5-6. Why is a mediator necessary? Why is Jesus the only one uniquely qualified to be our mediator?

Jesus reveals the person of God

- Read Revelation 1:5, Read Colossians 1:15. How does Jesus reveal the character of God? Why is it necessary for Jesus to show us who God the Father is? Why doesn't God the Father show us who he is? (maybe a trick question)

Jesus reveals that we will have a resurrected body

- Read 1 Corinthians 15:20-23. What does it mean to be "firstborn of the dead"? How is this encouraging for us? What does it mean to have a resurrected body? How would you describe what it means to have a glorified body?

Jesus reveals his purpose for us

- Read 1 Peter 2:9, Revelation 20:6. According to these verses what is our primary purpose? What does it mean to be a priest in these verses? How should we apply these verses on a daily basis?

Jesus is coming again

- Scripture provides a history of man from our creation to fall and then reconciliation. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:13-17 – what about these verses provide you with hope and peace? How do they show that we have a faithful God?
