- What is our proper response after we have a true understanding of the meaning of Christmas?
- What are some of the significant things we see revealed in Hebrews 1:1-2?
- Describe in your own words what the writer of Hebrews trying to convey to us in verse 3.
- What do we learn about angels and their roles and relationship with Christ in Hebrews 1:4-14? Why is this important to know?
- What do these verses say about God's creation and plan for the planet that we live in right now?
- Read Psalm 2. What are some of the insights we gain from these verses and how to they align with the passage we have read in Hebrews 1?
- Why did God become a man? Why is this so important to understanding the true meaning of Christmas?
