**Discussion Starter** – What are some of the Old Testament passages you remember that point to the birth of Jesus?

- Read Genesis 3:14-15, Genesis 21:2, and Isiah 7:14. What do these prophetic passages tell us about God's sovereign plan for His Son Jesus?
- Why do you think God remained silent, not speaking through prophets for 400 years prior to John the Baptist? How was the nation prepared to receive the announcement of God's promised Messiah during that time?
- Why do you think God chose to make His announcement to Mary instead of the ruling parties in Israel? What do we know about the 5 different groups in Israel (Pharisees, Sadducees, Herodians, Essenes, and Zealots) and why were they omitted from the divine announcement?
- When Mary questioned how it was possible for her to have a child without knowing a man, how did the angel Gabriel respond to her? How does this compare to the encounter the angel Gabriel has with Zechariah in verses 18-20? What are the key differences you see between them?
- How does the angel Gabriel encourage Mary and build her faith?
- Describe the mechanism God uses in (Genesis 3:14-15) the first mention in the bible of His plan to rescue humanity from the consequences of our sin.
- On what basis did Old Testament saints have a relationship with the God? How should we respond to the light He has given us?
- How was that promise (Genesis 3:15) fulfilled in Gabriel's announcement to Mary?

- Read Hebrews 2:10-18. How does Jesus' incarnation qualify Him to be "a merciful and faithful High Priest"?
