Passage: Genesis 5 - 6

Title: The Days of Noah

Discussion Starter – What do you think is the theme that is being conveyed to us by the title of the sermon message “The *Days* of Noah”?

Read Genesis 6:11 and 5:1-3: Define in your own words the implication of the world being corrupt and filled with violence.

Read John 3:16 and then read again Genesis 5:1-3: What does it mean to be Born Again in Jesus? Why is being born again necessary? What seems to impede people in believing this important truth?

Genealogy from Adam to Noah – (Genesis 5:1-32)

What things stand out to you as you read the genealogy of Adam to Noah in Genesis chapter 5?

How many years transpired from man’s first days on earth to the flood? What does this reveal to us about depravity of man and time?

What were some of the effects on a society of humans being able to live more than 900 years?

How might sin have looked different to Adam and Eve as compared to all those who born after them?

The Wickedness and Judgment of Man - (Genesis 6:1-12)

Describe what is transpiring in Genesis 6:1-2. Why might this passage seem difficult to comprehend?

Read 2 Peter 2:4-5 and Jude 1:6-7. What additional insights are gained from these scriptures?

What evil motive might be behind what transpired in this difficult passage? Explain.

What is God revealing to us in Genesis 6:3? Why is this passage, sometimes not correctly understood?

What is the 120 years referring to in verse 3?

What do you see is being revealed to us about God in verses 6:6-8?

In the midst of judgement what do these passages reveal about God’s heart?

What is the key *verb* in verse 8? What does this reveal about how Grace is imparted to us?

Read Genesis 6:9-12. What does “perfect in his generations” mean in verse 9?

What distinguishes Noah from “all flesh” in verse 12? Why?

“Just as in the Days of Noah”:

Read Matt 24:37-39. What point was Jesus making as He referred to the “Days of Noah”? What comparisons can you see with what was going on in the days of Noah to what is going on today?

Read 2 Cor 6:17-18 and Hebrews 12:1-2: What insights do these passages give us to how to live properly in a corrupt world?

Read Hebrews 11:5: What hope do we have as God’s redeemed children? What truth about God is revealed that encourages us to live in these difficult times?
