## Genesis 35:16-29:

- 1. Why do you think Jacob was heading to Hebron?
- 2. What is spiritual/significant/prophetic in the naming of Ben-Oni and Benjamin?
- 3. What is the significance of Benjamin being born in Bethlehem?
- 4. How are both of the names Ben-Oni and Benjamin fulfilled in Jesus? Read Isaiah 53:1-5, Matthew 26:63-64 and Hebrews 1:3
- 5. Why do you think God allowed Rachel to die?
- 6. How do you reconcile hardships in the life of a believer?
  - a. Has God ever used a hardship in your life to bring you closer to him?
- 7. What might have been the motivation behind Rueben doing the heinous act of sleeping with his father's concubine, Bilhah?
- 8. What does this act potentially reveal about his personal walk with Goad and Jacob's leadership?
- 9. What are the consequences of this act? Read Genesis 49:3-4

## What happens when we die:

- 10. Why is it that we ponder life after death?
- 11. Why do think that all civilizations have recordings of beliefs of going somewhere after we die?
- 12. Read Ecclesiastes 3:10-11: Explain what this passage means in your own words.
  - b. Why does knowing that eternity is written in all hearts give you encouragement? How can we convey this when witnessing to a non-believer?
- 13. Read John 16:8: What does this passage say the Holy Spirit work is to the world of non-believers? Why is this important?
- 14. Read Daniel 12:2-3, 1 Corinthians 15:38-44 and John 5:28-29: What are some of the significant things these passages reveal to us about what the Bible says about life after death?

## Luke 16:19-31:

- 15. What is significant about Jesus giving us the name of the beggar in this story?
- 16. Where did non-believers and believers' souls go after death before Jesus?
- 17. Where does a believer's soul go now?
- 18. Why didn't a believer's soul go to heaven before Jesus' death on the cross?
  - c. How has this message helped you to have a mindset more focused on eternity?
  - d. How has this message encouraged you in your daily walk and attitude towards witnessing to others?
