Discussion Starter – How do the angels who did not keep their proper domain tie into the apostate men that Jude is referring to who have crept in unnoticed?

Read Jude 1:6-10 and Genesis 6:1-9

- 1) Describe what impacted you the most about this sermon and if you learned something new about the angels judgement who did not keep their proper domain?
- 2) What are some of the characteristics that stood out to you most in the sermon with how to identify apostates?
- 3) What were the fallen angels' sins and what consequences were they given?
 - a. What can we as believers learn from Jude's warnings and judgements of these fallen Angels?
- 4) What do you think was Satan's goal in having some of his fallen angels to have relations with women and how does this relate to Noah and the flood? Read Genesis 6:8-9.
- 5) What does it mean to you to personally contend for the faith? Who do you think Jude is primarily addressing this message to? How do you think we should we start contending for the faith. Read 2 Chronicles 7:14
- 6) What are some of the apostate types of doctrines that have crept into the Church that many Christians have bought into?
- 7) How do you think we can better equip ourselves to recognize apostates who try to come into our church?
- 8) Why do you think we have so many people who are deceived by apostate teaching?
- 9) How would you describe what it means to be hyper spiritual? What are some examples of hyper spirituality and why should this be considered an attribute of apostasy?
- 10) How can we differentiate between hyper spirituality preaching and the bold proclamation of God's truth
 - b. Have you ever been tempted to act or pray in a hyper spiritual way? Why do you think we are motivated to do so?
- 11) What are some of the character traits of the apostates we see Jude listing in verse 8? Which stands out to you them most and why?
- 12) How do you think the apostates sees themselves? What is the spiritual problem identified in verse 10? Read 2 Corinthians 4:4. What additional insights are gained from this passage?
- 14) What lesson do we learn from the sermon about how to deal with true spiritual battles?
