Passage: Daniel 9:27, Revelation 13 **Title:** Israel's Final 7 Year Period

Discussion Starter – The scope of events described in Daniel 9:24 are to be completed within the 70 weeks determined for the Jewish people. What elements or details of this scope remain to be completed during the final 7-year period? Hot does this prophecy contradict reformed, amillennial, post millennial, preterist, or replacement theology assumptions of eschatology and the return of Jesus Christ?

Read Daniel 9:26-27

- 1. What event marked the end of the 69th week?
- 2. What is predicted to happen after the 69th week?
- 3. Who are the "people to come"? Who is their Prince?
- 4. What event(s) will mark the beginning of the 70th week? (Daniel 9:27 and Romans 11:25)
 - a. What reasons are given to falsely assert that God is finished with Israel?
 - b. What will God accomplish with Israel, for Israel, and through Israel for the benefit of the world during their final 7 years?
- 5. What specific event occurs in the middle of the 70th week? What major facility is implied to be constructed prior to this event?
- 6. Who is the key figure of verse 27? How will he attract a worldwide consensus?
 - c. What is the risk of settling for temporary peace while neglecting truth? What is the difference between a peacekeeper and a peace maker?
 - d. Are you sometimes tempted to overlook or ignore bad behavior to achieve a lack of conflict? When might this be wise? When is this foolish?

Read Revelation 13

- 7. What references to Daniel do you see in this chapter that confirm the identity of the beast?
- 8. How does the information in verses 5-6 correlate to what happens in Daniel 9:27, "the middle of the week"?
- 9. Who is the dragon who gives power to the beast, Revelation 13:2? (see Revelation 12:3)
- 10. How does our enemy deceive and tempt us using political, religious, and financial power to obscure the Truth?
 - e. How does a political position, a financial position, or a religious position that offers hope for mankind stand in opposition to Jesus' teachings of the core values of His Kingdom?

Read 2 Thessalonians 2:9-12

- 11. What "signs, lying wonders, and deceptions" are commonly circulated today that are meant to deceive us?
 - f. Where do you place your confidence to avoid falling into these deceptions?
