Discussion Starter – What exactly is faith? How do you think most people define faith? What is worthless faith?

Read Psalm 50:1-6

- 1. Who is speaking? To whom is He speaking? What is He announcing?
- 2. What language and terms are used to portray God as awesome, magnificent, and deserving of absolute respect?
 - a. How do you reconcile God as a consuming fire, while also knowing Him as our Good Shephard?
- 3. On what basis or standard is God said to be judging His saints in this psalm, (verse 5)?

Read Psalm 50:7-15

- 4. To whom is God speaking to in this portion of the psalm? Is He refusing to receive their sacrifices?
- 5. Is God for or against his people?
- 6. Does God desire additional offerings? What does He request from His people, (verse 14-15)?
 - b. What does it mean to "pay your vows"? How are marriage vows similar or different from vows to God?
 - c. What vows have you made to God? Are you fulfilling them?

Read Psalm 50:16-21

- 7. To whom is God speaking in this portion of the psalm? What are their identifying practices?
 - d. Why are these practices in verses 17-20 provided as sure evidence of a dead or worthless faith? What are identifiers of true faith?
- 8. Does God's silence imply His approval? What misunderstanding does God identify in these people?
 - e. In what ways do you confuse God's ways with your own? Where can we accurately learn about God?
- 9. What steps does God take to correct and lead us in paths of righteousness for His Name's sake?

Read Psalm 50:22-23

- 10. How do these verses describe God's fearsome passion as well as His lovingkindness?
 - f. What does this psalm teach you to better understand the relationship God desires to have with you?
